
Is your fleet **Chain of Responsibility compliant?**

SPEED: ensuring vehicles and drivers do not exceed the speed limits.

Ehubo2 also captures essential information on the driver's behaviour and provides immediate coaching to remedy any issues immediately.

An EROAD study has found that **vehicles where the driver was logged in had 50% less speed events** than vehicles with no identified driver.
